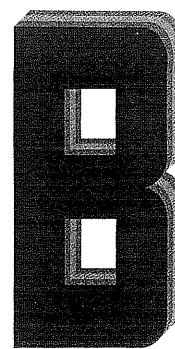

## UPGRADING

This proposed new football Stadium will form part of a 2010 FIFA World Cup™ purpose built-multi-sports and practice complex, which is earmarked for development on a picturesque open tract of elevated land situated 6 kilometers north of Nelspruit, the capital of Mpumulanga province.

The proposed Stadium site is well serviced by road. A major highway, which is an easy three and a half hour drive east of Johannesburg, links the 2 cities. Nelspruit also enjoys a direct rail link to Johannesburg and a special rail link will service the new Stadium.

Mbombela is in a fast growing region with important axes, north to the Kruger National Park and White River and also the East-West Corridor to Mozambique.

The region requires a modern sports Stadium to accommodate the many sports fans in the area.

The site is very prominent on the Northern outskirts of Mbombela on the way to the Kruger National Park.

The new facility will be specifically designed to meet the requirements of FIFA.

## TECHNICAL DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED MEASURES

- ◆ Installation of one new video display boards in north stand;
- ◆ Installation of 4 dual line electronic scoreboards;
- ◆ New masts and floodlights and installation of new floodlight system in line arrangement as part of the new roof structure;
- ◆ New public address sound system and installation of a new distributed sound system;
- ◆ New main intake substation;
- ◆ New video surveillance system; and a
- ◆ New fire detection and protection system.

## TECHNICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE FACILITIES

The new venue operations centre will be situated on level 1. The technical control centre where the Stadium public address announcer, scoreboard operator, video replay screen producer and technical assistants are seated will be situated, will be on the same level (Level 1).

## VIP AREAS

Specially secure and comfortable presidential suites and lounges are available for 500 VIPs and guests of honour ensuring the best service. Toilets and sanitary facilities are in the direct vicinity.

## CORPORATE HOSPITALITY/SPONSOR

There are 40 corporate hospitality suites that view the playing field and seat up to 960 guests.

Two function rooms located directly behind the main stand can accommodate 220 seated guests.

The Stadium will be able to accommodate the required number of Media representatives.

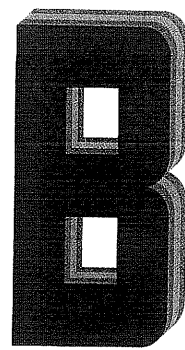

The Media centre and the mixed zone will be in close proximity on level 1 in the western pavilion.





## SECURITY

The proposed layout of the sports precinct is conducive to being secured and barricaded from a spectator safety and security perspective and will provide more than adequately for all categories of FIFA specified vehicular parking requirements.

The fact that the Stadium is being purpose-built for the 2010 FIFA World Cup™ will ensure that safety and security planners are placed in a position to ensure that the entire layout of the Stadium and its outer precincts are designed in strict accordance with best international sports Stadium safety and security practices and FIFA specifications.

The entire precinct will, in terms of the concentric rings of security theory, have 3 secured perimeters which will progressively be used to filter and screen match ticket holding spectators as they approach the Stadium.

The outer perimeter (traffic warning zone), will extend to a maximum of 800 metres from the inner perimeter of the Stadium. The entire outer perimeter will be serviced by an outer ring road which will encircle the Stadium. This outer perimeter will be used to filter pedestrian and vehicular transported match ticket and accreditation holders from the general public.

The middle perimeter (traffic-free zone), the outer extent of which will be demarcated by a robust steel palisade security fence serviced by two emergency/VIP vehicle gates and four primary spectator flow points (secured by large robust gates), will extend a distance of 200 metres from the inner perimeter of the Stadium and will encircle the Stadium.

An inner ring road will encircle the Stadium just outside of the outer extent of this purpose-designed middle perimeter for accredited person drop-off and emergency/VIP vehicle access purposes.

Strict screening of spectators for prohibited and restricted items will take place at four specially designed primary spectator search points which will be located at the four primary spectator flow points into this perimeter. The search areas will be equipped with search tables and walk-through and hand-held magnetometers. A further visual match ticket check will take place at this point.


A secured VIP and service vehicle screening area ('remote search park') manned by State security services, equipped with magnetometers, conveyor belt type X-ray machines and bomb detection and disposal equipment will also be located just outside of this middle perimeter. It will be situated at a purpose-built vehicle ramp and inspection facility at least 200 metres away from any primary spectator flow point.

The inner perimeter will feature four zoned spectator electronic ticket and accreditation verification turnstile areas consisting of no less than 45 turnstiles.

Each spectator and accredited person will be individually processed at these turnstiles. Generic, clear and visible Stadium layout ('You are here') and restricted item and match ticket condition signage will be erected throughout the entire precinct.

A further advantage of this new purpose built Stadium is that it will afford safety and security consultants the opportunity to assist the Stadium designers with the design of a functional and fully electroni-





cally and physically secured outside broadcast compound for the use of official broadcasters. This facility, which will be under 24-hour CCTV surveillance, will be located inside the inner perimeter of the Stadium.

The general spectator area of the inner bowl of the Stadium will be divided into four quadrants ('zones') where FIFA-approved competing team spectator separation measures, demarcating each zone, will be in place.

An aesthetic and functional physical field perimeter security system, designed in strict accordance with FIFA specifications, will be put in place around the entire field of play. A physically secured and convenient participating player and match official field of play access route will be incorporated into the Stadium design.

A purpose designed and built venue operations centre, from where the entire safety and security operation at the Stadium will be directed, on a 24-hour basis, throughout the tournament, will be located at a secure location on the northern side of the inner bowl of the Stadium.

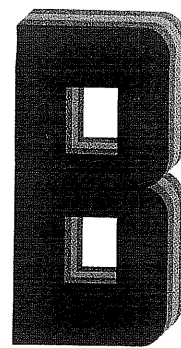
The venue operations centre will be equipped with the digital control system of the Stadium and Sta-

dium precinct's planned multi-zone CCTV surveillance and recording system, computer equipment and peripherals, computer-linked projector, electronic public address cut-in, dedicated multiple telecommunications lines and real-time data links to the electronic ticket/accreditation verification system and the Mbombela Metro disaster management centre.

The design of the Stadium and the entire outer precinct will include the incorporation of a world class multi-zone digital CCTV surveillance and recording system. This new installation will extend to the extent of the outer perimeter and all of the primary spectator pedestrian and vehicular access routes to the Stadium. A particular focus area will be the four planned spectator screening areas which will be situated at the middle perimeter.

The planned system will consist of a minimum of 16 cameras, 5 colour monitors, 3 remote-controllers and a digital compression and analogue backed-up recording and play-back facility. All of the cameras will have a 360° pan, tilt and zoom and low-light capability. The entire control system will be installed in the Stadium venue operations centre. The system will have a real-time video and audio link to the Mbombela Metro disaster management centre.

Biometric face recognition software will also be incorporated into the CCTV system to enhance the proactive surveillance capabilities of the on-site safety and security personnel.



## **STADIUM EQUIPMENT**

### **Public Address Sound System**

The new Stadium will be equipped with a distributed, zoned public address system for all public address and announcements including voice evacuation. It will be possible to select individual and/or combinations of zones. Master control units will be installed in the Stadium manager's office, the technical operation centre and the venue operations centre.

The master control unit in the venue operations centre will take priority at all times enabling non-delayed override. To ensure uninterrupted operation, the master control unit will be placed on an uninterrupted power supply.

The public address system will be linked to the broadcast compound area as well as the video replay screen to enable both the audio and visual aspect of flash/field interviews and advertisements. The public address sound system will also cover the gating perimeter of the Stadium.

### **Electronic Scoreboard and Video Replay Screen**

The Stadium will be equipped with one new combination high-resolution LED video replay screen and LED full matrix information boards. These boards will be utilised as a real time multimedia communication system, displaying text, graphics and video material. In addition, four dual line LED scoreboards will be installed to cover the match score.

The new installation will also include the software and all video production equipment. The production team and technical assistants will be situated in the technical operation centre.

### **Floodlights**

The floodlighting system will be installed on the new roof structure. The floodlighting system will have a light intensity of 1,500 lux.

### **Emergency Power**

The Stadium will be equipped with a distributed emergency power system in order to ensure that all essential systems will remain functional in the event of a power failure. Essential systems include the venue operations centre, the technical operations centre and access control systems.

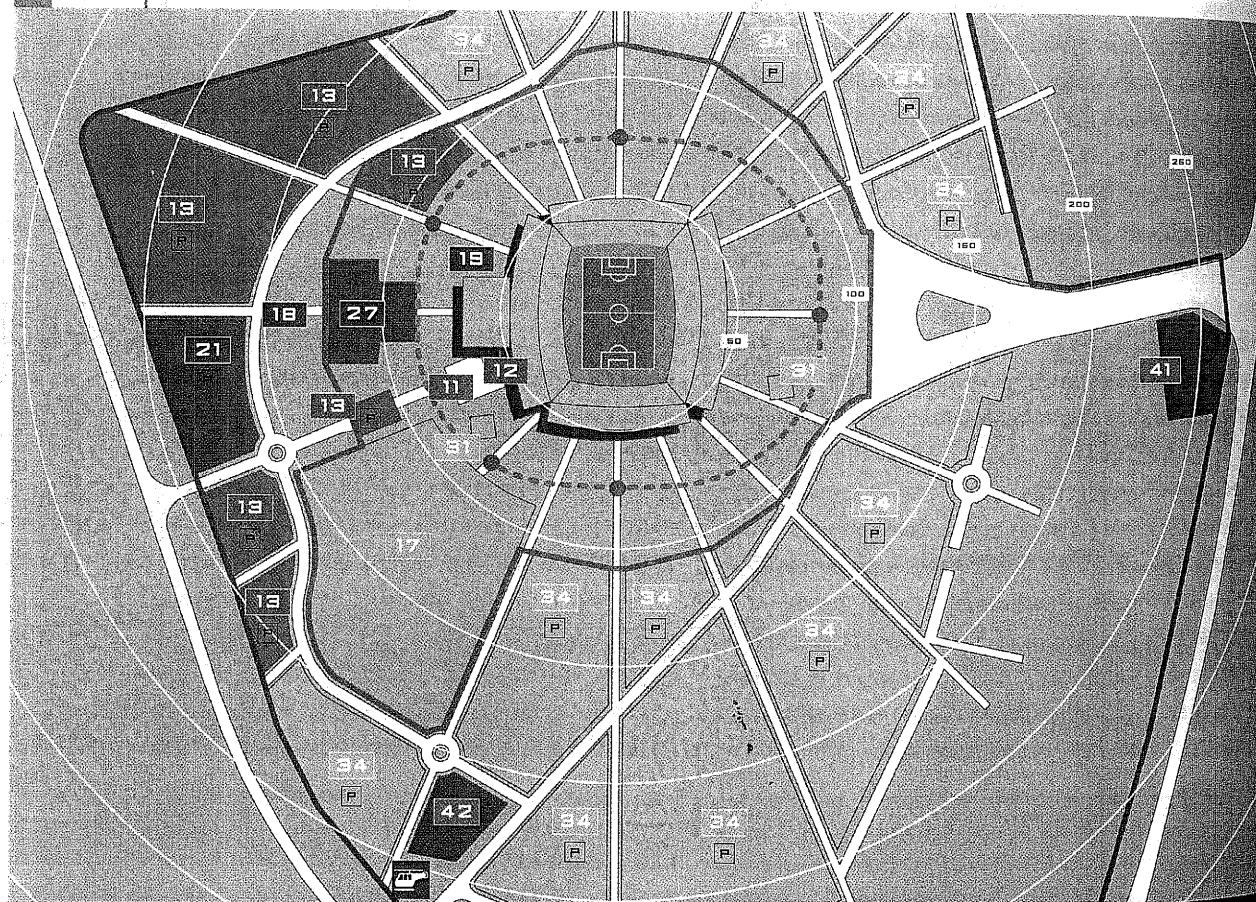

## **FINANCING**

The total cost of the construction of this new Stadium will be in the region of CHF 75.5m (USD 28.8m); and the provincial government of Mpumalanga and the Mbombela Municipality have guaranteed to fund the costs of constructing the new Stadium.
